



OWASIPPE PACKING LIST



Scout Shirt (required at the dining hall for dinner)

Neckerchief and slide (Newer Scouts will be given this at crossover ceremony before camp)

Scout book

At least one pair of long pants -- Horseback riding and some climbing require pants. Not to mention it can get cold at Owasppe at night (seriously)

Shorts

T shirts-- If you have Scout themed T-shirts this is the place to wear them

Underwear -- More than one pair

Socks and not just the ankle ones-- at least a couple of pair that go over the ankle

Sweatshirt or jacket-- Last year it got into the 40's on some nights

Toothbrush

Toothpaste

Soap

Pajamas or designated sleeping "outfit"
